


PRESIDENT'S REVIEW

Kaukomarkkinat enjoyed a record year in 1996. Overall sales, which describes our volume of trade. exceeded FIM 4 billion for the first time and net sales also reached new heights at FIM 3.7 billion. However. the most gratifying figure was that the net profit from operations for the year was FIM 66 million, another all-time high in Kaukomarkkinat's history. These record-breaking figures are particularly pleasing to announce as Kaukomarkkinat will be celebrating its 50th anniversary about the time this review will be published. The excellent results are the best recognition of the hard work put in over many years by the company and all its personnel.

Kaukomarkkinat went into business 50 years ago during the extreme hardship of post-war recovery. Finland had suffered destruction in the war but successfully maintained its independence, although heavy postwar indemnities burdened the nation's industry and economy. This was when Kaukomarkkinat was founded to export Finnish products to inaccessible, distant markets and to import, at first mainly by bartering, the food and raw materials that Finland so sorely needed. Today the world has been totally transformed, and so has Kaukomarkkinat. Our core businesses are importing and wholesaling the leading branded goods in Finland as well as broadbased international trade and exports with Russia, China, Poland and the Baltic states as the prime market

Looking back at the trend in domestic trade, it may be said that trade in consumer goods grew substantially in comparison with the previous year. The only exception in Kaukomarkkinat's fields of business was textile imports and wholesale, which continued to suffer during the first half of the year from Finland's application of transitional customs tariffs on non-EU textile imports at higher rates than those of other EU countries.



In Kaukomarkkinat's domestic business, the best success was won by adidas sporting goods, Panasonic consumer electronics and Citizen watches, all of which increased their sales considerably more than the overall market growth in their lines and further strengthened their market leadership. Sales of Panasonic's office automation and telecommunication products were also on a distinctly positive trend. On the other hand, sales of industrial electronics products declined because capital expenditure by the Finnish electronics industry had not reached the previous year's level. The progress of our Optics unit suffered from heavy price competition in the field. Leipurien Tukku expanded its sales steadily and in line with objectives.

In international trade, the greatest growth came from export projects of Panasonic consumer electronics to Russia. Other trade with Russia was held back by unstable economic conditions. In particular, there was a considerable decline in imports of wood and raw materials. On the other hand, there was growth in exports of consumer goods to Russia and to the Baltic states. We succeeded in selling considerably more of our transit services than expected in spite of difficult market conditions.

Among our branch offices outside Finland, Poland once again did best, strengthening its market positions in almost all its fields of business. In our China trade, exports of capital goods for the wood processing industry once again represented our strongest area of expertise. Also, our exports of health-care products increased to China. In importing from China, we will devote more and more effort to consumer goods.

The 1996 fiscal year was also special to Kaukomarkkinat in that Kesko Ltd became our new owner. Kesko is Finland's biggest corporation in the wholesale and retail business. Our new owner opens up significant new opportunities for expanding our operations, and we also offer Kesko an opportunity to benefit from our skills on the global market.

In closing, I would like to thank all our customers, our principals and other business partners as well as our employees for the good work we have done together, making it possible for us to achieve record results in honour of our anniversary. We appreciate our long-lasting relationships with our customers and principals and we shall continue to devote greater efforts to improving our relationships and to constantly enhancing customer satisfaction. Our sincere goal is for all our partners to do profitable business with us for many years to come.

EAST-WEST TRADE WITH EXPERIENCE AND SKILL

Trade with Russia is one of the strongest areas of Kaukomarkkinat's expertise. In this important business area, our company has decades of experience. Our professional skills and flexible operations have won the complete confidence of our principals and customers.

The broad experience and good business contacts of our company's East-West trade professionals are a guarantee for successful cooperation. We employ some 40 Russian-speaking trade specialists. Kaukomarkkinat has a special commitment to establishing direct contacts with product manufacturers and end users. We are at home in the market.

Local offices growing in importance

In business today, it is essential to keep a close eye on customers, markets and development right around the clock. We have our own representative offices in Moscow, St Petersburg, Ufa, Perm and Petrozavodsk. Acting as our sensors on the spot, the local offices are effective in assisting the development of trade, serving our many customers and principals in their areas.

A broad spectrum of exports

We continually export technology and consumer goods, and we have participated in project deliveries. Our main export products are various kinds of machinery and equipment for the forest and wood-processing industry as well as for the oil, gas and glass industries. Within construction and project exports, many of our agreements have been on a turnkey basis.

Our growing range of export products includes furnishings, textiles, clothing and leisure products, consumer electronics and various consumer goods as well as foodstuffs.

Imports for industry

The main emphasis in our imports has been on raw materials. Our customers now include industrial, processing companies in Finland and third countries.

From Russia and the Baltic states we import timber as a raw material for the forest industries in both Finland and other Nordic countries. Our wood trade is built on a solid foundation of pulpwood deliveries. We are strongly committed to a high level of customer service.

Through our extensive network of supplier, we obtain various plastic raw materials and chemicals for industry, and we export industrial products both as counter-trade and direct exports.

Trade with third countries

We constantly develop our trade between Russia and third countries, arranging also financing and counterpurchase obligations. Our company is known as a trustworthy partner in both the East and the West.

Handling and storage services for chemicals and oil products

For exports of petrochemical and chemical products from the CIScountries and especially from Russia, Finland is an economical and important transport route. In order to serve customers using this route, we have a transit tank terminal in Hamina, a major Finnish seaport some 40 kilometres from the Russian border. Our tank terminal has 26 storage tanks with a combined capacity of almost 100,000 cubic metres. The terminal can handle, store and blend heavy and light oil and a number of chemical products, transported by rail or by sea, throughout the year. The Hamina facility has heating equipment for heavy oil products as well as steam and inert gas systems which facilitate convenient, economical and reliable product handling.

Oil products from East to West

We supply feedstock, fuels and chemicals from CIS-countries to the oil and petrochemical industry in western Europe.

Industrial maintenance

We also supply economical and environmentally friendly, highperformance lubricants for industry and transport in Finland and other countries.

Amongest our services we provide information systems for factories and other special products and services, including both maintenance software and measurement and analysis.

Kauko Condition Monitoring specializes in package-deliveries of monitoring systems. The main customers are companies in oil, gas, and chemicals, and the pulp and paper industry in Russia and Finland.









WORLDWIDE TRADE

Comprehensive coverage in China

Kaukomarkkinat is a Finnish pioneer in trading with China. Our trade has expanded and we are the leading commercial firm in Sino-Finnish trade. We have our own offices in Beijing, Shanghai and Guangzhou.

High-tech to China

Our exports consist of technology for the wood processing industry and electrical power industry and for environmental protection, as well as health-care equipment, industrial filters, and production lines for the mineral and building materials industry. In raw materials business, we have launched exports of steels, pulp and paper to China.

Light products and raw materials from China

Our purchasing organization for imports from China has been expanded both geographically and in terms of product areas. We have increased the proportion of local staff in China. Our imports emphasize textiles, household appliances, footwear, electronic products, chemicals, and raw materials for the food industry.

Imports from China to Finnish wholesalers and distributors are growing. Our direct purchasing sources for textiles are Chinese manufacturers and export organizations. In addition, we have developed new, competitive procurement areas in Vietnam, India and surrounding regions. We also export goods from China to third countries: to Central Eastern Europe, the EU and Russia.

Building materials to Japan

Japan is one of our most challenging market areas. Our exports include granite stone for the monument and construction industries, as well as building materials, sawn timber and log houses.

Technical trade in Eastern Central Europe

We have our own organization operating in Central Eastern Europe, Kauko-Metex. Our subsidiaries operating in Poland, Hungary, Germany, the Czech Republic and Slovakia specialize in importing, marketing and international trading in machinery and equipment. We also do business through local offices in Bulgaria and Romania.

Our international trade has grown dynamically. Of major importance has been the growing volume in our business of industrial products manufactured by German principals.

We first did business in Poland 30 years ago. Our Polish subsidiary imports machinery and equipment for the paper industry and forest industry, along with electrotechnical equipment and instruments, and feedstock for the ceramics and plastics industries. We export foodstuffs from Poland to Western Europe. Environmental technology and effluent treatment are among our strong fields, handled by our subsidiary Metex-Huber.

Our company in Germany specializes in global trade in reconditioned metalworking machinery. Rotating grinders refitted to high standards have become a unique alternative for our customers. The German company also sells complete metal surface-finishing lines.

In the Czech Republic and Slovakia, we supply production control systems for the process industry. We also market automated warehouses, which are needed in these countries as part of the logistics chain. In addition to machinery and equipment for the forest industries, we also sell consumables required by the chemical forest industries within this region.


In Hungary, we concentrate on the paint, electronics and forest industries. We also supply machinery for the sheet-metal processing engineering industry.

In the Balkan countries, we market machinery and equipment for the mechanical and chemical woodprocessing industry.

Southeast Asia and Africa

Our Metex Singapore office's market area embraces a broad region of Southeast Asia. Our office markets metal and technology products made by manufacturers in the Nordic region and continental Europe to shipyards and engineering plants. We have gained a strong position as a supplier in this region, especially with high-specification pressure vessel components for the petrochemical industry, including dished ends, casings, flanges, and couplings.

In Africa, our efforts are concentrated on Harare, Zimbabwe, where we are a major marketer of electrotechnical products and sawmills.







LEADING INTERNATIONAL BRANDED GOODS

In the import trade, Kaukomarkkinat Oy specializes in the import and marketing in Finland of leading international branded goods. The branded products we represent are the best in their field, products of the highest quality, in which consumers can place their trust when selecting sporting and leisure goods, watches and home electronics as well as optical and photographic products. Our best-known branded goods are adidas, Citizen, Panasonic, Polaroid, Rodenstock, Silhouette, Technics and Yashica.

Through our long-term, systematic work, we have created a solid foundation for our cooperation with international producers of branded products. An important link that complements this cooperation is our dealer network in Finland. They are the leaders in their respective fields, as are the branded goods Kaukomarkkinat represents. Absolute trust and long-term cooperation with the different parties involved in the trade are the foundation upon which we build our operations. We shall continue to do so in the future.

On the sporting goods market, adidas and its symbol - the three stripes - are a concept. The importing and marketing of adidas products is handled by our subsidiary Virsu Oy, which specializes in the sporting goods trade.

Top names go with adidas


